

PET TRAVEL 101:

TIPS FOR YOUR NEXT ROAD TRIP

Buckle up

Pets should travel in a well-ventilated carrier/crate, or secure your pet with a safety harness in the backseat. Get your pet acquainted ahead of time!

CREATURE COMFORTS:

- A favorite blanket or pillow
- Familiar toys
- Food and treats
- Pheromones

DAILY ESSENTIALS:

- Bring plenty of bottled water and spill-proof portable bowls
- Withhold food several hours before travel to minimize motion sickness
- Don't forget clean-up bags and litter boxes

SMOOTH SAILING:

- Stop every few hours for exercise and bathroom breaks
- Never leave pets in a parked car

Plan for emergencies

- Microchip your pets
- Get a collar with ID tags
- Bring medical records and photos of your pet
- Pack a first aid kit
 - o Include gauze, bandages, hydrogen peroxide, tweezers, prescribed medications, and a pet first-aid guidebook
